The Market at Belmar Hosts Bocce Tournament to Kick Off Summer-Long Play

LAKESWOOD, CO (April 26, 2006)—To kick-off free summertime bocce play, the Market at Belmar is hosting a tournament from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday, May 21 on Saulsbury Street at Belmar (Wadsworth and Alameda). There is no entry fee and no experience is required to play in the popular Italian game similar to bowling.

For those who do not wish to join in the tournament but wish to hone their skills, there will be an open bocce court.
