Join the Rink at Belmar in helping the homeless or near homeless in Jefferson County. Simply drop off a “Core Four” donation: a packaged protein, pasta, canned vegetables, and soup by April 1 at the Rink at Belmar located near the corner of S. Teller Street and W. Alaska Drive in Lakewood and enjoy outdoor ice skating for free.

Donations will be accepted while the rink is open for skating from 4 to 9 p.m. Thursdays and Fridays and from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
